






Abstract Postural tachycardia syndrome (POTS) is a form of chronic orthostatic intolerance for which the hallmark physiological trait is an excessive increase in heart rate with assumption of upright posture. The orthostatic tachycardia occurs in the absence of orthostatic hypotension and is associated with a 5-6-month history of symptoms that are relieved by sympathetic tone, mast cell activation, deconc autoantibodies.
